### Administration Services

- The Township of Leeds and the Thousand Islands has granted an exemption to Noise By-Law 22-049, Section 2, Subsection 2 to the Seeley's Bay Canada Day Celebrations taking place at Centennial Park for the day of July 1, 2024 from 10:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m..

### Fire Services

#### Fire Services

- Fire Services responded to 9 incidents: 3 medicals, 1 fire (structure), 1 burn complaint, 2 motor vehicle accidents, 2 remote alarms.
- Have received 180 calls for 2024 which is an increase of 35 calls at this same time last year.
- Chief Prior, DC Robertson, and Lt Kirkland traveled to St. George, Quebec to complete the final inspection on the new Tanker 12, which will go into service in mid-July.
- All applications were received for Lieutenant positions at Stations 1 and 3. Interviews and testing will be scheduled over the next two weeks. These positions complement the current officer roles and maintain proper supervision ratios.

### Fire Services Cont'd

#### Regional Training Center

- Redemption codes have been issued for the upcoming NFPA 1002 Pump Ops Course. The online portion will begin on June 28, and the in-class session will take place from August 9 to 18.
- CPKC Railway 101 course equipment and props have arrived. The course is scheduled for Saturday, June 29, and 30 students are enrolled.
- Palmer doll house has been donated to the Brockville Fire Department for their "Belles and Ladders" camp for girls in July. This doll house will be used to educate the participants on fire behavior.

#### Fire Prevention

- A Fire Safety Plan for a Vulnerable Occupancy was completed and signed off.
- Dates have been scheduled with the LTI Public Library to participate as a guest reader in their "Star of the Community" reading program over the summer. Firefighters will be present to engage with the children's groups.
- Dealt with 3 burn complaints and issued fines for one unauthorized burn.
- Pre-Plan visit and training completed at construction site of new Gananoque Hotel with members from Station 3 and Gananoque Fire Service.
- One fire investigation completed.

### Operations & Infrastructure

#### Parks

- Maintenance and mowing is ongoing.
- Kendrick's Beach received a notice from the Health Unit that the beach is at a caution level and not recommended for swimming. The Health Unit tests the beach water every week and sends notices out when there are concerns about the water quality.
- A picnic table was delivered to Ford St. in Lyndhurst to replace one that was no longer functional.

### Roads

- Deryaw Road capital project – Ditching/culverts continues.
- Roadside mowing is ongoing.
- Dust suppressant program is ongoing with 89.5 km of 151.3 km completed.

- Tree removals completed. Both instances were after hour call ins.
- Hard top patching to roads continues.
