Fire Services

- Fire Services responded to 6 incidents: 3 fire alarm, 2 medical and 1 possible vehicle fire.
- Station 1 hosted a dinner, September 9 to celebrate the promotions of eight Lieutenants.
- To honour and mark the 23rd anniversary of the September II, World Trade Centre attacks, six Leeds Firefighters, under the lead of Station 2 Firefighter Ruttan paid respect to the 343 Firefighters who paid the ultimate sacrifice that day by climbing the equivalent of 110 storeys (the height of the former World Trade Centre towers) in full protective equipment.
- A pumper, tanker and rescue were placed on Hill Island for three days to cover sporadic short full closures of the Thousand Islands Bridge. This will continue over the next two weeks. Vehicles will be removed from the island in between closures.
