Fire Services

- Fire Services responded to 13 incidents: 4 medical assistance calls, 4 fire alarm activations, 2 burn complaints, 1 public hazard, 1 police assistance and 1 motor vehicle collision.
- Leeds Fire Services successfully received a Fire Prevention Grant from the Ontario Fire Marshal's office. This grant for cancer prevention will assist them in purchasing equipment to help reduce cancer risks among firefighters.
