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Fire Services

Fire Administration

- Fire Services responded to 12 emergency incidents: 2 motor vehicle accidents, 2 medical assist calls, 1 public assistance for an accident, 3 carbon monoxide calls, 1 vehicle fire, 1 power line down and 2 structure fires.
- A Co-op student from Gananoque Secondary School completed his fall semester at Leeds Fire Services. The Fire Services take pride in participating in Co-operative Learning. The last two students from this program have successfully joined the Fire Service at Stations 1 and 3.
- The new marine unit (boat) for Station 3 has arrived. The remaining equipment will be installed over the winter to ensure it is ready for use in the water by spring 2025. This boat will be permanently stationed at Brennan Marine during the season

Fire Prevention
